

Card Games

5 card poker – 5 down, 3 trade or 4 with an A.

5 card stud – 2 down, 3 up

7 card stud – 2 down, 3 up 2 down.

7 ½, 27 ½ - closest to 7.5 or 27. 5 wins, A= 1 or 11, face cards = .5, all others are face value, deal til they say stop, ante to take a card.

Acey, Deucey – two sides, bet for middle, can bet whatever amount, lose you put in, win you take out, new hand for each game.

Blitz – 3 cards down, 31 to win, face cards =10, A = 1 or 11 all other face value, go to seven cards.

Bingo – deal up or down, even # for all, reserve 15 cards (called cards by dealer), lose all cards wins, cards left enter to pot.

Baseball - 3 & 9 wild, 4 = another card, wild card pays on up card, dealt 2 down, 3 up, 2 down, bet after each card.

Follow the Queen – 2 down, 3 up, 2 down, queens are wild, if a queen is dealt up (person pays on it) plus next card is wild).

Indian – 1 card placed on the forehead, bet or pull out based on everyone else's cards.

Jacks to Open, Trips to Win – 5 cards dealt down, pair of jacks opens game, if none are dealt, game starts over, pot stays in, must ante again for next game. No more than 3 new cards can be dealt, only trips or better win the game. (can get very \$\$\$ game).

Let It Ride – 3 cards down, .25 a card, dealer deals 3 and buries 1, dealer flips first, bet to stay or no, pair of 10's or better to win.

Midnight Baseball – played the same as baseball, except 1 card is flipped until the last person is beat, ante for 3's, 4's, 9's, lose all cards you are out, high hand sets the bet.

Straight beats a Flush – opposite to win, only 3 cards dealt per person, only rid 2 cards.

Texas Hold'em – 2 down, burn 1, 3 up, burn 1, 1 up, burn 1, 1 up
